

Embedding External Content or Code on Your Site

You can add content from many third-party providers using the Embed Code element.



Find the embed code for whatever you're looking to add to the site. This can usually be accessed via an embed or share button found on or near the content you're looking to share.

Here we see an example of embeddable code connected to a video that is hosted on Vimeo.com.



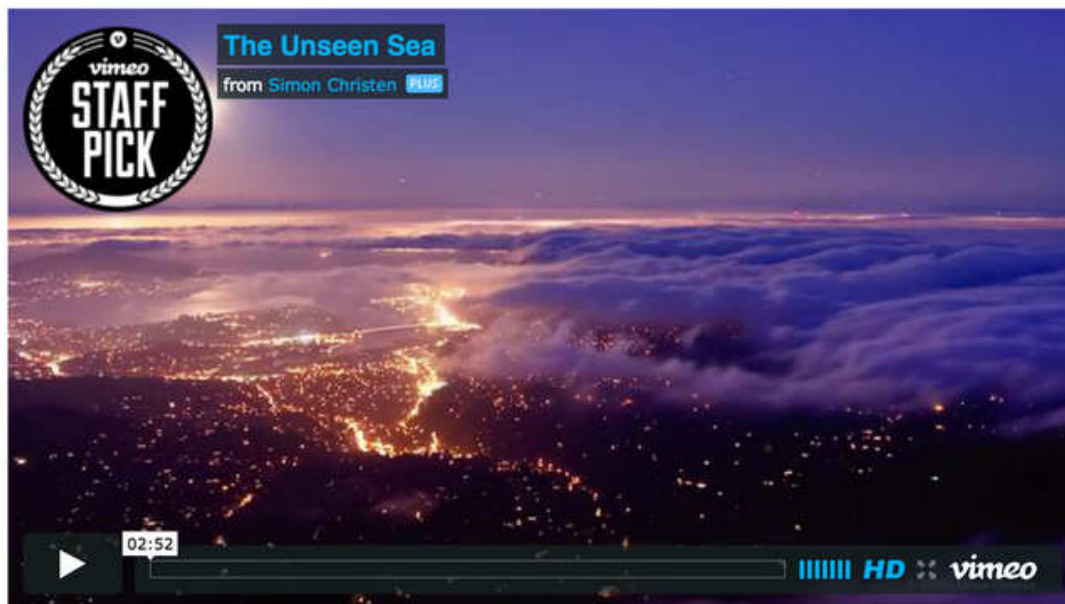

Once you locate the embed code, copy it to the clipboard (**Ctrl+C** or **Command+C**). Then click inside the Embed Code element and paste it in place (**Ctrl+V** or **Command+V**).

Note: There are a few situations where the content you've embedded won't show up on your site until you Publish the changes. So if you don't see your video, form or what have you in the editor, try Publishing to see if it shows on the live site.
